

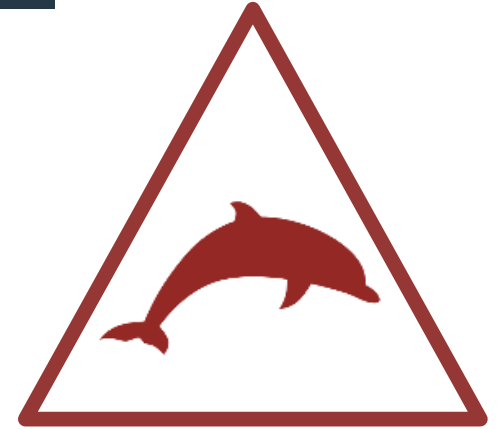

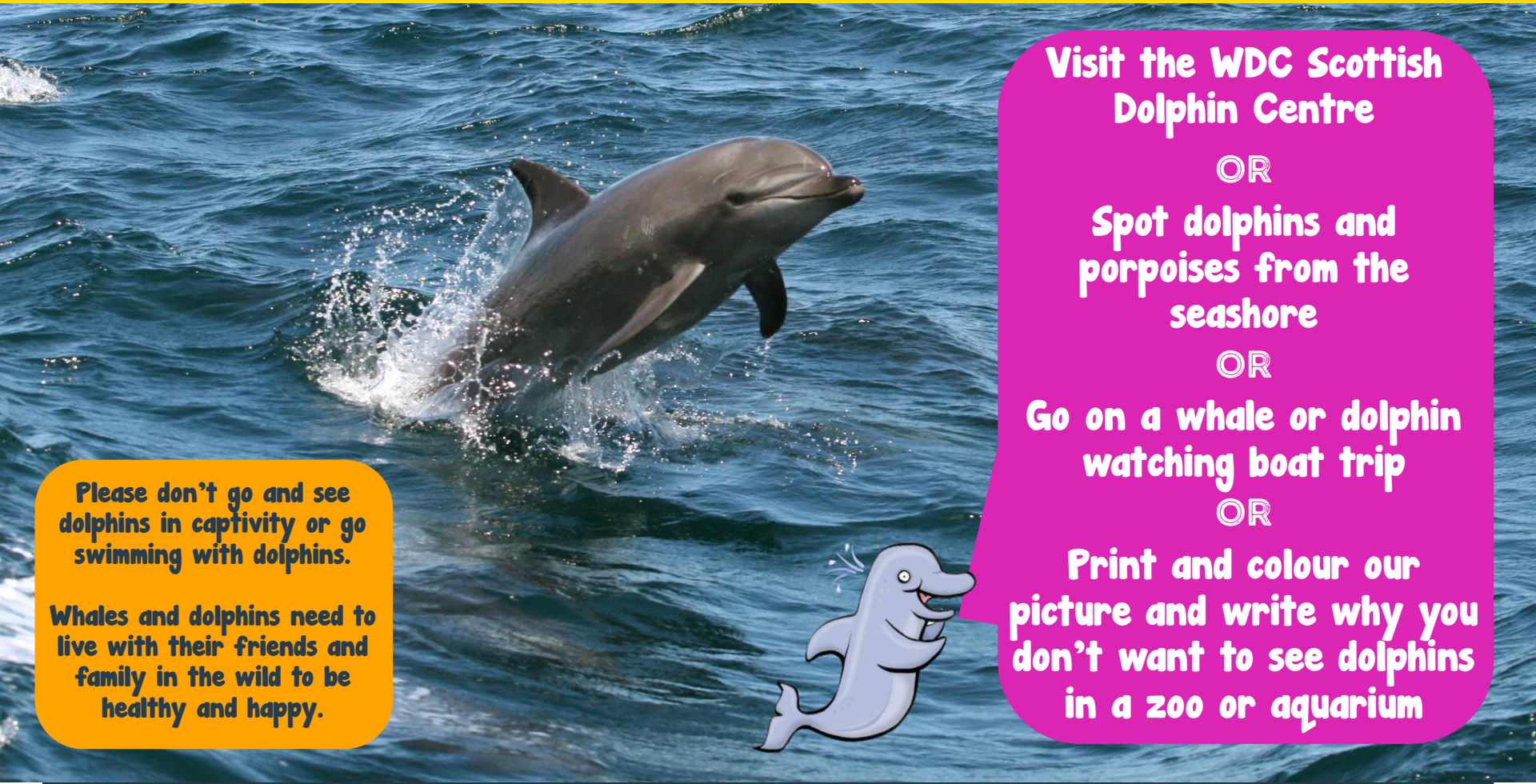

OR

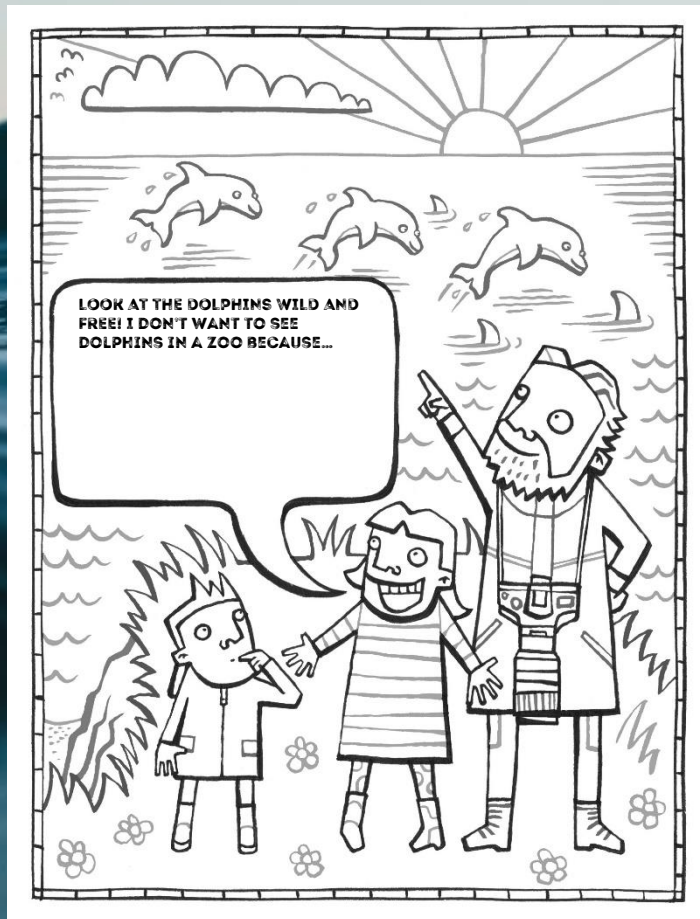

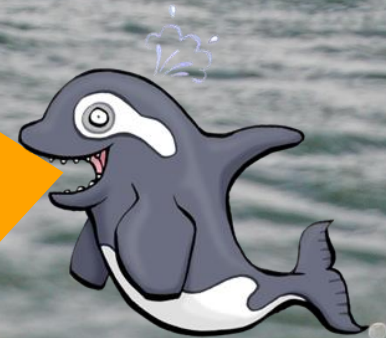


# MAKE A POSTER

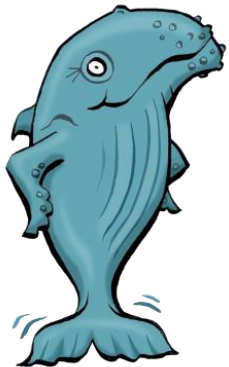
